WITH REGARD TO QUARTERLY AUDITS....

The CDC guidance and orders from law enforcement and the government related to gatherings should be followed. However, audits can be circulated by email for review and signature. Additionally, you do not have to have a monthly meeting to complete the audit. You have a full 30 days after the end of the quarter to complete and submit an audit which should be sufficient even when arrangements must be made.

Audits are an important element of financial integrity in our organization. They are due April 30th for the period of January 1st through March 31st.

1. COMMANDER'S MESSAGE:

"May you live in interesting times." Often said to be an ancient Chinese curse, there is no substantive evidence that the saying was an ancient or modern Chinese curse. The expression was traceable to the British diplomatic service in China circa 1936. That being said, we certainly are living in interesting times. With the CORONAVIRUS making its way through the country we must adjust our daily lives to minimize exposure.

The Commander in Chief has issued an executive order allowing Posts to delay elections until their next meeting. Current elected officers will remain in office until that process can be completed.

Section 203 of the National By-Laws allows Posts to hold electronic meetings subject to certain conditions. I authorized Posts to conduct electronic meetings even if they had not previously adopted procedures to do so. Their meeting could be conducted on a telephone conference bridge, by video, email or any other suitable method. The takeaway is that Posts must strive to hold their nominations and elections. The Commander in Chief's directive does not authorize a Post to indefinitely postpone elections.

On a lighter note, on March 2, I was privileged along with my counterpart Auxiliary President Marcia Semones, to escort Virginia's Voice of Democracy winner Sophie Crowder to the stage at the VFW's annual parade of winners in Crystal City. Sophie, from South Hill, placed just under the top tier of winners and was awarded \$2000 for her essay.

Recruiting and retention during this trying time can be a challenge. That doesn't mean we can just stop. Posts should be working their unpaid lists to try and get members to renew. It doesn't require face to face contact, just a phone

call. Consider sending them an email letting them know a call is forthcoming. That way they might just answer the phone.

We are still working to get a new Post in Kilmarnock and 3 Posts over the 50-member hump. Chief of Staff Tom Hines reports that Amherst, Tasley, Stuarts Draft and Lebanon are possibilities.

In closing I urge everyone to stay healthy and take the precautions that the CDC is recommending to thwart the spread of the Corona virus.

There are no provisions in the National By-Laws, nor is there any authority or justification for issuance of Club Membership cards. Associate Member cards, Honorary Membership cards, Courtesy Membership cards or any other special type of cards. Any Post issuing such unauthorized cards, or conducting club operations open to the general public, endangers its standing with the Internal Revenue Service as a non-profit organization. Officers signing outlaw cards admitting non-members to VFW premises are subject to disciplinary action. National and Department officers cannot defend practices that conflict with VFW By-Laws or procedures

4. AUDITS:

Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 218(a)(11) of the National Manual of Procedure, Officers: Duties and Obligations. Trustees Report of Audit must be prepared in detail within thirty (30) days from the end of each quarter, one of which ends March 31.

5. AWARDS:

Awards and All-State judging information were in last month's General Orders, along with the various entry forms.

6. BY-LAWS COMMITTEE:

The National and Department By-laws are the governing document of the organization. Along with the National Manual of Procedure and National Ritual, there is nothing not covered but none of these are permanent documents. Should your Post or District feel there is a need for change, propose and pass the change you wish to see. Please send those adopted recommendations, with a cover letter signed by the Post or District Commander stating when the motion was adopted, to the State Headquarters **NO LATER THAN MAY 1**ST. Those properly recommended will be considered at the State Convention in June.

District officers shall not assume the duties of their office until the Department Commander is installed. District officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed in accordance with Section 416 of the Manual of Procedure.

Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 222 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, which provides that each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a tendollar (\$10) delegate fee.

Posts are encouraged to register their Post delegate(s) online through the Online Membership System (OMS) or by submitting their National Convention Post and Delegate Registration form that was mailed to all Posts as part of the Election Report/Convention Registration mailing that went out in February. Advanced registration for the 121st National Convention should be mailed with each delegate's name and address to: Convention Registration, 406 West 34th Street, Kansas City, MO 64111.

19. POST ELECTIONS:

Installing officers will see that the provisions of Section 216 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure are properly carried out and that all officers are members in good standing and qualified to hold office prior to installing Post officers for the current year. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

ONLINE ELECTION REPORT

Online reporting is the preferred method of submitting the Post's 2020-21 Election Report. As Post Quartermaster, you will log into <u>vfw.org</u> accessing "My VFW." You will then click on the link "Online Membership System." You will find, in the left navigation pane "Election Report"; open the drop down and click "Post Election Report Filing." You are now ready to use the newly enhanced reporting procedure. Follow the step by step process, verify your summary, make any necessary corrections and submit. This is a 5-7 minute process for the average user.

Quartermasters who need assistance setting up their Online Membership System (OMS) account should review the "Quartermaster Guide to Member Dues Processing" training document located in "VFW Training and Support" under "Member & Officer Training, Forms & Templates." In addition to the annual Election Report, this system will be utilized to make officer changes during the administrative year.

Although a return, postage paid envelope has been included in this year's mailing, we ask that you make every attempt to use the online reporting method. **Do not mail or fax your report if you have utilized the online reporting method.** Your report can be submitted by mailing one copy to the Adjutant General **or** fax to 816.968.1120.

NOTIFICATION

Changes in Post Officers will also be acknowledged by email to the Post Quartermaster's and Department Headquarters email addresses.

Post Quartermasters will receive a "Post Record Acknowledgment" via USPS. This card is used to show the reported change of the Post Commander, Post Quartermaster and/or Post Dues Amount. Only return this card to correct erroneous information. Corrections can also be made by accessing the OMS.

NATIONAL BYLAW - SECTION 222

Delegate strength shall be <u>one for every thirty (30) members</u> or fraction thereof in good standing. Delegates and alternates shall be elected in accordance with the Manual of Procedure.

Each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a ten dollar (\$10) delegate fee.

NATIONAL MANUAL OF PROCEDURE - SECTION 222

Delegates and alternates for the National Convention shall be elected at a regular meeting in April. Delegate strength will be based on members in good standing as of March 31.

<u>ONLINE</u>

Online submission is the preferred method of submitting the National Convention-Post & Delegate Registration Fee(s). As Post Quartermaster, you will log into <u>vfw.org</u> and access "My VFW." You will then click on the link "Online Membership System." You will find, in the left navigation pane "National Convention"; open the drop down and click "National Convention Registration" and enter desired membership information. This is a 3-6 minute process for the average user. <u>Please have the membership number available of all delegates, alternates and attendees you are registering.</u>

Only a Post or Department Quartermaster, utilizing this system, can register the Post's delegates online. Members accessing the National Convention website are registered as attendees only.

The Post registration fee of \$25 must be remitted *prior* to the convention; Post delegates will not be able to register their credentials unless this fee is paid.

EMAIL OR PHONE

Commanders, Quartermasters or Adjutants may report any changes to a delegate's status through the Member Service Center via email at msc@vfw.org or by calling 833.VFW.VETS (833.839.8387). Please have the membership number available of all delegates, alternates and attendess you are registering.

MAIL-IN OR FAX

Enclosed with this notification is an invoice in the amount of \$25. Quartermasters may fill out and return this invoice using the enclosed pre-addressed, postage paid envelope. This form must be signed by the Adjutant or Quartermaster. The Post registration fee of \$25 must be remitted *prior* to the convention; Post delegates will not be able to register their credentials unless this fee is paid. When using the enclosed form you are required to include the membership number, name and address of all delegates, alternates and attendees you are registering.

DEFINITIONS

- Delegate- Member (in good standing) of the Post elected to represent the Post in all business activity at the National Convention. Delegates elected under Section 222 of the National Bylaws and Manual of Procedure shall not be considered instructed and may exercise full authority in the duty performed.
- Alternate- Member (in good standing) of the Post elected to represent the Post in all business activity at the National Convention in the event the elected delegate cannot attend. Alternates not fulfilling the role as "delegate" are considered "attendees."
- Attendee- Any member in good standing may register for the National Convention. Registering for the National Convention is another way a member can show support for VFW programs. The \$10 registration fee entitles the member to a convention packet which may be picked up at the convention.

NOTIFICATION

Post Quartermasters will receive letter confirmation that the Post is registered.

Delegates, alternates and attendees will receive a confirmation letter. Included in this letter will be a request for emergency contact information. We are asking all to fill-out and bring this form with them to convention; this is voluntary, but recommended.

All notification will be sent USPS, 3-5 days after processing.





National Convention - Post & Delegate Registration

Section 222 of the National Bylaws states "Each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention.
