# The Colonial Downs and Virginia Veterans Foundation VFW Veteran's Home Improvement and Assistance Grant

The purpose of the Colonial Downs and Virginia Veterans Foundation Veterans Home Improvement Assistance Grant is to provide funding to VFW Posts in Virginia to assist with projects to improve, expand, or repair the home of a veteran or widowed spouse in need. There will be three (3) \$2500 grants and one (1) \$5000 grant for the 2025-2026 year. All requirements must be met, or the Post will be required to return the grant, in part or in whole, depending on the circumstances. **Grant application is due no later than September 30, 2025.** 

The requirements of the grant are as follows:

- 1) Projects must be initiated and completed in the period of October 1, 2025, through March 31, 2026. The Post must submit a thorough justification for the grant.
- 2) The VFW Post in question must have a current non-profit status on file with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and must provide the IRS paperwork proving this.
- 3) The Post must be in good standing with the VFW National and Department Headquarters.
- 4) The veteran must own or lease the home and must provide a copy of the documents showing either ownership or a current lease. For veterans who lease the property, there must be at least 2 years remaining on the lease and the home improvement must be used to make the home handicap compliant to receive a grant. Veterans who own their home do not have this restriction.
- 5) Receipts for the project or bills covered by the assistance requested must be provided at the end of the project. Payment of the grant will be made to the supplier or contractor.
- 6) Should the project costs or assistance requested total less than \$2500.00 once complete, the balance of the grant will not be paid. If total cost is greater than \$2500, the Post will be responsible for remaining payment. The same applies to the \$5000 grant.
- 7) The VFW Post and veteran receiving the grant must agree to allow the VFW Department of Virginia and Virginia Veterans Foundation the opportunity to promote the funded project on social media, in official communications, and in other forms of marketing.
- 8) All decisions on grants are final and will be made by the Board of Directors of the Virginia Veterans Foundation.
- 9) Funding from this grant program may be combined with other grants but the total of the funding received cannot exceed actual costs and the amount received from this grant may be reduced accordingly.
