2. ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP:

The National Bylaws provide for only one type of membership: active membership. There are no provisions in the National Bylaws, nor is there any authority or justification for issuance of Club Membership cards, Associate Member cards, Honorary Membership cards, Courtesy Membership cards or any other special type of cards. Any Post issuing such unauthorized cards, or conducting club operations open to the general public, endangers its standing with the Internal Revenue Service as a non-profit organization. Officers signing outlaw cards admitting non-members to VFW premises are subject to disciplinary action. National and Department officers cannot defend practices that conflict with VFW Bylaws or procedures.

3. BUDDY POPPIES:

State Headquarters has Buddy Poppies (old or new) in stock. The new price for the original buddy poppies (red ones) are \$160.00 per 500. The price for the new metal poppies is \$70.00 per 500. As a reminder poppies must be paid for before they can be shipped.

4. BY-LAWS AND MANUAL OF PROCEDURE:

All officers should obtain current 2024 copies of the podium edition of the Congressional Charter, Bylaws, Manual of Procedure and Ritual. Copies of the revised edition of the Congressional Charter, Bylaws, Manual of Procedure and Ritual are available through the VFW Store at National Headquarters. The 2024 revised edition reflects the amendments adopted by the 124th National Convention, which becomes effective on August 20, 2023.

5. CALENDAR RAFFLE:

Once again, I want to thank everyone for the support so far on the calendars. The feedback so far has been positive, and I hear that they are selling. Keep pushing. Take them with you on your recruiting events and buddy poppy events. Buy a few as stocking stuffers! Give one to a Vietnam Veteran or a new member. 6. CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION TEACHER AWARD:

District judging should be completed by **December 10th** and winners forwarded to the Department chairman by **December 15th**. Department judging will be held on **December 20th**.

Post and District Adjutants must report required information through **Dashboard** in order to get credit for participation. This new reporting system is a replacement for the reporting previously done by District and State chairpersons. It is critical that it be accomplished in order for Posts and Districts to get credit for participation in the All-State and All-American programs. District Chairperson will still submit reports to the State Chairman in order to supplement the State **Dashboard** reporting. Reporting forms for the District chairpersons will be provided to the District Commanders.

Post chairmen must be sure to send the original nomination form, essay and official VFW Post teacher entry form of the winner from each grade's category – along with one-page resume, up to five (5) pages of documentation and a good quality head and shoulders photograph from the winning teachers.

9. DUTIES OF TRUSTEES:

Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 218 of the Manual of Procedure, "Duty of Trustees." Trustees Report of Audit must be completed in detail at the close of each quarter, one of which ends December 31, 2023. Commanders are reminded that accurate and complete records shall be kept by all persons handling Post funds, including the Club Manager, Bingo Chairman and VFW Riders Groups. These records shall be audited by Post Trustees in the same manner as Post Quartermaster and Adjutant records.

10. E-MAIL ACCOUNT ACCESS:

All email accounts were reset so the new Officers could take control of their emails as of **June 13th**. This will be the primary means of sending correspondence from State Headquarters to Post and District Officers. You will receive all General Orders, special notices and any other documentation that you need via email. This will help cut down on postal expenses and speed up the response time for you receiving the information.

- 3. The username is your email address; put that on the first line (see below for your new address).
- 4. Your default password will be **VFW2023!** once you have accessed the mail program you will be asked to change it; it must contain at least one uppercase letter and one number.

11. HALF-STAFF U.S. FLAG:

Public Law 103-308, passed in 1994, designates Dec. 7 as "National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day" and requests the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff (sunrise to sunset) in honor of the individuals who lost their lives on that day. To order a flag, go to vfwstore.org/category/flags/usflags.

- 2. A Post may only submit one entry in the 2023-2024 VFW year for consideration against other entries from that District.
- 3. Only one citation per District will be presented in the 2023-2024 year, regardless of the number of entries received from that District.
- 4. Drafts for the award, which shall detail the reasons for the award, must be submitted to Ken Wiseman at kwiseman@vfwva.org by January 24, 2024, without exception.
- 5. Presentations will occur starting in March 2024, and awardees must agree to participate in photographs for use by the VFW in all forms of media.
- 6. The final decision of those who receive the award will be in line with the expectations of the National HQs and shall not be appealed.

The entry form along with the required documentation are to be returned to the local VFW Post for their judging. Once a winner in each category has been chosen, the Post will forward the winning entries on to the next level of judging.

Simply visit vfw.org, log in to My VFW, then look under Member Resources, click on VFW Training & Support, then click on Community Service & Youth Programs, then look under Public Servant Program.

25. STATE SURGEON:

Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Awareness

Hello, Comrades of Virginia; after visiting several Posts in Virginia, we want to bring awareness to dementia this month. Also, the resources below can assist loved ones and the families who provide love, care, and support.

Alzheimer's is a type of dementia that affects memory, thinking, and behavior. Symptoms eventually grow severe enough to interfere with daily tasks. Dementia is caused by **brain cell loss or damaged cells, which impairs the brain's ability to function normally**. People are more likely to get dementia if they have a family history or minor cognitive impairment. Each type of dementia affects the brain differently and is distinguished by distinct brain changes.

The most common forms of dementia include:

- Alzheimer's Disease
- Vascular Dementia
- Lewy Body Dementia
- Frontotemporal Dementia
- Mixed Dementia

If dementia is suspected, an early diagnosis is crucial so that you or your family can receive the medical care and assistance that you require. See the website below to learn the signs of Alzheimer's.







Dear Post Quartermaster,

With the support of the VFW National Headquarters and the VFW Department leadership, the National Council of Administration passed a resolution at the August 28th Council meeting that makes it mandatory for all Posts and Departments to sign up for Automated Clearing House (ACH) payments from the National Headquarters by December 31, 2016.

What is ACH and what does this mean? ACH is a method for the National Headquarters to electronically submit payments to Posts and Departments. ACH is one of the most secure, fastest and efficient payment methods available today. When an ACH payment is transmitted, the deposit will typically be available in the payee's account the following business day. If you provide an e-mail address, you will also receive an e-mail notification whenever a payment is transmitted to your account from National Headquarters, and that e-mail will explain the purpose of the payment.

After December 31, 2016, the National Headquarters will no longer be issuing paper checks to Posts and Departments. Historically there have been thousands of checks to VFW Posts and Department that have gone uncashed, and by signing up for ACH, that issue will be eliminated.

Attached is the ACH application form that needs to be completed and signed. You are also required to attach a voided check from the appropriate bank account.

Thanks for your assistance in making the VFW more efficient.
